We have a supply of bright yellow bags for members to use for spring clean up along the roads of the Buck Lake community. During the week of April 26<sup>th</sup> to May 3<sup>rd</sup> we encourage everyone to take the time to "pitchin" and collect the harvest of a long winter. Those items that can be recycled can be placed in your Blue Boxes and of course you are welcome to put a down payment on a new boat with the money you make from all the beer cans and bottles you find. For all other materials collected, use the bright yellow garbage bags and place them out with your garbage for regular collection.

We have a supply of bags available for Buck Lake residents. 
