


To comply with the expected COVID regulations, we will be discouraging people from arriving by car. Some docking will be available, to use the washroom facilities and return to your boat.

We have all heard about various reports and research that discusses the need to take of our lakes and some of the activities, human and otherwise, that may negatively impact the health of lakes. But what about Buck Lake specifically? Well, the Township of South Frontenac has designated \$60,000 in this year's budget that could help us find out!

Last year, the Township created the Lake Ecosystem Advisory Committee and one of their tasks was to create, in conjunction with Township staff, the Lake Ecosystem Grant Program. The committee has been hard at work, such that the Township recently announced the inaugural grant program! Briefly, the purpose of the Lake Ecosystem Grant Program is to establish a grant process that supports and encourages the preservation, restoration, monitoring and analysis of lake ecosystems within the Township of South Frontenac. A lake ecosystem basically refers to an inland body of water that lacks any direct contact with an ocean. Lake ecosystems include living plants, animals and micro-organisms, as well as non-living physical (e.g. light, temperature and wind) and chemical reactions.

Within this broad scope, the Township has identified four priority areas for funding:

- A. Reduces or limits diffuse or point source runoff primarily caused by human disturbance of the land
- B. Creates or increases buffer zones along the lakeshore and/or banks of creeks and streams that drain into the lake
- C. Protects or enhances wildlife habitat
- D. Enables or performs monitoring and/or inventories of the lake environment and its contributing watershed in order to fill knowledge gaps

So, if you are interested in getting help to test the latest research in mitigating Eurasian milfoil in Buck Lake, or need funds to help Buck Lake loon or turtle or other wildlife population to grow or would like to know what trees and plants specific to Buck Lake geography are best to re-naturalize Buck Lake shorelines (and get some help to plant them) or want to better understand why and what can be done to mitigate algal blooms, or if there has been any negative impact to


